The Observatory for the Analysis of International Systems (OASIS), an indexed and peer-reviewed journal, is presently soliciting contributions for its first issue of 2025 (OASIS No. 41). The theme for this issue will be: "The International Insertion of the Republic of Korea in the Contemporary World: Achievements and Challenges".

The Republic of Korea has undergone an astonishing transformation on the international stage, positioning itself as a key player in various fields and facing significant challenges on its way to a successful insertion into the contemporary world. In the 21st century, South Korea has demonstrated remarkable resilience and adaptability that has enabled it to become an economic and technological leader, as well as a reference in global cultural diffusion. It is essential to understand how these advances have contributed to its growth and projection in the international arena, both in terms of its presence in the global economy and in the promotion of its culture and values through the "Korean wave" or "Hallyu".

Issues such as social and economic inequality, environmental sustainability and diplomacy in a complex geopolitical context are topics that deserve in-depth analysis and critical reflection. Through this special issue of OASIS, experts, researchers and scholars are invited to contribute their perspectives and analyses to a better understanding of the obstacles and opportunities facing the Republic of Korea in its process of insertion into the contemporary world.

The guest editor for the 41st issue of OASIS is **Dr. Kim Won Ho**, emeritus professor, and former dean of Hankuk University of Foreign Studies (HUFS) in Seoul, Republic of Korea. He previously served at the Korean Institute for International Economic Policy (KIEP) as director for the Americas; research and administrative director and senior research fellow for 13.5 years. He taught at the Universidad de las Américas (Mexico) and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (USA) before joining HUFS in 2007. In addition, Professor Kim is Advisor to the Korea Foundation, Member of the Korea Pacific Economic Co-operation Committee (KOPEC), Advisor to the Korea Consumer Agency, Advisor to the Northeast Asian Community Studies Institute (NACSI), and member of the board of the Asia Economic Community Foundation (AECF).

- Articles may be written in Spanish, English, French, or Portuguese.
- Articles submitted to OASIS must not have been published previously.
- Articles must be written in Microsoft Word. The maximum length of the articles must be 9,000 (nine thousand) words, single space, Font Arial 12, 2.5 cms top and bottom margins and 3.0 cms left and right margins. They must include a reference list, notes, pictures, or figures if needed.
- References must follow APA format, which can be found at: https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines

- Authors must include an abstract in English, Spanish, and the original language of the article (in case it is different from Spanish and English). OASIS can help with translating the abstract into Spanish or English in case the author does not speak these languages. The abstract must include the key elements

- of the article and cannot be longer than two hundred and fifty (250) words. Four to five key words must also be included
- Authors must include last academic title, field of research, institutional affiliation, and e-mail.

FINAL VERSION OF THE ARTICLE:

The final version of the article shall be uploaded through the Open Journal System (OJS) platform in our website (https://www.uexternado.edu.co/oasis) no later than June 10th, 2024.

BOOK REVIEWS:

OASIS will also accept reviews of books that have been recently published (not older than two years). Book reviews may be written in Spanish, English, French, or Portuguese and must be approximately 2,000 words long. Book reviews must be sent to OASIS through the Open Journal System (OJS) platform in our website (https://www.uexternado.edu.co/oasis) no later than June 10th, 2024.
